1. Call to Order: Mayor Pro-Tempore Jackson calls the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

2. Consent Agenda:

Action: Berg motions to approve the June 22, 2010 minutes with a correction as follows, “Roll Call: Present – Kathy Berg, Merle Jackson, Terry Herrin, Christine Broughton, ~~Charlie Button~~ and Bill Graham. Absent - Charlie Button.” Broughton seconds motion. No discussion. Motion carries unanimously.

Action: Herrin motions to approve Claims Voucher Nos. 35897-35922 as audited by the Finance Committee in the amount of \$81,333.05. Graham seconds motion. No discussion. Motion carries unanimously.

Action: Berg motions to approve Payroll Warrant Nos. 33196-33230 for June 30, 2010 in the amount of \$45,684.37. Herrin seconds motion. No discussion. Motion carries unanimously.

3. Special Guests/Public Comment

Jackson opens the public hearing to receive public comment on the Off Road Vehicle Ordinance at 7:07 p.m. Kris Takemura opposes ordinance citing safety issues. Bud Mills opposes ORV Ordinance citing safety, noise and environmental issues. Don Campbell opposes ordinance citing potential mischief. Jennie Dickinson opposes ordinance citing safety, insurance liability, and enforcement issues and economic development impacts. Kathy Blake opposes ORV Ordinance citing safety concerns. Dave Schreck suggests that ORV facilities be constructed outside city limits. He expresses concern about lack of insurance requirements for ORV's. Jay Ball opposes ORV ordinance citing contradictory statements within the Ordinance's language, expressing that the proposed map does not make sense and requests Council review the RCW's governing ORVs. Nancy Hoffman opposes ordinance citing noise issues. Carrie Chicken points out that the map is incorrect on the City's website. Bob McCauley opposes proposed ORV ordinance and expresses concern regarding the City's liability as a result of the ordinance. Delphine Bailey opposes proposal due to safety concerns.

Public hearing is closed at 7:35 p.m.

Lisa Ronnberg, Chamber Director, reports on 2010's 2nd Quarter tourism and economic development activities, current status of the Columbia County Fairgrounds Committee's Community Survey project, Dayton Development Task Force's new advertisement plan which will be in cooperation with Columbia County Public Transportation System, Bluewood Committee update and status of Historic Preservation Walking Tour brochures project.


