

ORDINANCE NO. 1829

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 5, CHAPTER 12, SECTION 840 OF THE DAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE, APPEALS OF ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS OR REQUESTS FOR INTERPRETATIONS.

Whereas, the City of Dayton, Washington, on November 16, 2001 adopted Ordinance No. 5-12.840 pertaining to the appeals of administrative decisions or requests for interpretations, and

Whereas, said ordinance did not provide for any time limit within which to file said appeal or request, and

Whereas, the City has been advised by legal counsel that it is advisable to provide for such time limit, and also is advisable to have the appeals or requests heard and decided by the Planning Commission, and finding that it is in the best interests of the City of Dayton to do so,

Now, therefore, the City Council of the City of Dayton, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title 5, Chapter 12, Section 840 of the Dayton Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:


5-12.840 Appeals of administrative decisions or requests for interpretations.

- (A) Appeals of Administrative decisions or requests for interpretations that relate to this Chapter or the Comprehensive Plan shall be filed with the City Clerk within twenty-one (21) days of the date of the decision, order, requirement or determination of the City Planner or his designee.
- (B) Appeals of administrative decisions or requests for interpretations shall be heard and decided by the Planning Commission.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the publication of the attached summary, which is approved.


