ORDINANCE NO. 1831

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON ACCEPTING A CASH DONATION FROM THE DAYTON SKATE CLUB.

WHEREAS, Revised Code of Washington 35.21.100 allows cities to accept donated money or property by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Dayton Skate Club has made a generous offer to donate \$599.29 towards improvement to the Dayton Skate Park with conditions; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of the Dayton Skate Club's donation are to install a second gate on the west side of the Dayton Skate Park nearest to the Dayton Swimming Pool and any funds remaining following installation of a gate shall purchase one bike stand to be placed by the new gate; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to fulfill the conditions of the donation in exchange for the cash donation of \$599.29.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. Approval to Accept Donation.</u> The Dayton City Council accepts the donation of \$599.29 from the Dayton Skate Club to install a second gate on the west side of the Dayton Skate Park nearest to the Dayton Swimming Pool and any funds remaining, following installation of a gate, shall purchase one bike stand to be placed by the new gate.

<u>Section 2. Other Actions Authorized</u>. The Dayton City Council hereby authorizes the Public Works Director to take actions necessary to implement this decision and to fulfill the City's obligations in accepting the Dayton Skate Club's Donation as stated in Section 1.

<u>Section 3. Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the other remaining parts which shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4. Effective Date.</u> This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
