ORDINANCE NO. 1845

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 4-5 SECTION 88-MONTHLY UNIFORM SEWER SERVICES CHARGES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1825

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Dayton as follows:

<u>Section 1. Section 4-5.88 of the Dayton Municipal Code (DMC) is hereby amended to read as follows:</u>

DMC 4-5.88 Monthly Uniform Sewer Service Charges Within and Without the City of Dayton, Washington. The following monthly and/or yearly charges and rates as indicated shall be paid by the users of the City of Dayton sewer systems, or the owners of premises connected thereto, unto the City of Dayton, Washington, in accordance with the following Character of User and Monthly Rates schedule:

Section 2. Upon passage by the Council and publication as required by law, the sewer rates established herein shall take effect on January 1, 2014. The rates set

forth in DMC $\underline{4\text{-}5.88}$ which is amended by this ordinance shall remain in force and effect until the rates set forth in this ordinance go into effect.

Section 3. Effective Date. A summary of this Ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
