ORDINANCE NO. 1868

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2014 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1842, NOVEMBER 25, 2014, AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1865 ON SEPTEMBER 8, 2014.

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton adopted the 2014 budget in final form by Ordinance No. 1842 on the 25^{th} day of November, 2014; and

WHEREAS, subsequent thereto it has become necessary for the City to amend said ordinance to account for unanticipated revenues resulting in unanticipated expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Dayton, as follows:

Section 1. The following funds contained in the City of Dayton 2014 Budget are hereby amended **to change revenues and expenditures** as set forth below:
