## ORDINANCE NO. 1872

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 1 CHAPTER 2 OF THE DAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE, ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF CITY OF DAYTON CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dayton has determined that Councilmembers time may be better served if there were one regular meeting per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. Amending certain sections of the Dayton Municipal Code. Title 1, Chapter 2 of the Dayton Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 1-2.04 Regular meetings. The regular meeting of the City Council for the City of Dayton, Washington shall be held on the second Monday of each month, except for the following months: November's City Council meeting shall be held on the second and fourth Monday and December's City Council meetings shall be held on the first and third Monday. Should any meeting fall on a legal holiday, then such meeting shall be held the next regular business day at the same date, time and location.
- 1-2.06 Open to the public. All regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Dayton shall be held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall unless otherwise specified, at seven o'clock p.m. and shall be open to the public.
- 1-2.08 Special meetings. All special meetings shall be held at a date and time specified by the City Council and pursuant to RCW 42.30.080. Such meetings shall be held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall unless otherwise specified, and shall be open to the public.
- SECTION 2. Severability: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the other remaining parts which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date: A summary thereof of this Ordinance consisting of its title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
