

## **RESOLUTION NO. 1465**

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO TAKE TESTIMONY FOR OR AGAINST THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY ON EAST J STREET**

**WHEREAS**, a petition has been filed with the City of Dayton pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW to vacate public right-of-way located in the City of Dayton, Washington; and,

**WHEREAS**, the petition received requests vacation of a portion of E. J St., between S. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. and S. 4<sup>th</sup> St.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the portion of the right-of-way is 10' wide and is along the north side of E. J St. between S. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. and S. 4<sup>th</sup> St.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the portion of the right-of-way being petitioned to be vacated is a total of 3,392 square feet; and,

**WHEREAS**, the current infrastructure development does not utilize the entirety of the right-of-way; and,

**WHEREAS**, 100% of adjoining property owners have signed the petition requesting vacation of the right-of-way; and,

**WHEREAS**, the public hearing on such petition may be held before the legislative authority upon the date fixed by resolution.

#### **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** Pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW, it is the intention of the City of Dayton to hold a public hearing concerning the vacation of a portion of E. J St.

**SECTION 2:** Pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW, a public hearing is hereby set for May 12, 2021 at 6:00 pm. The public hearing hereby requests testimony for or against the proposed vacation and will be held by the Dayton City Council. All persons interested may appear and be heard.

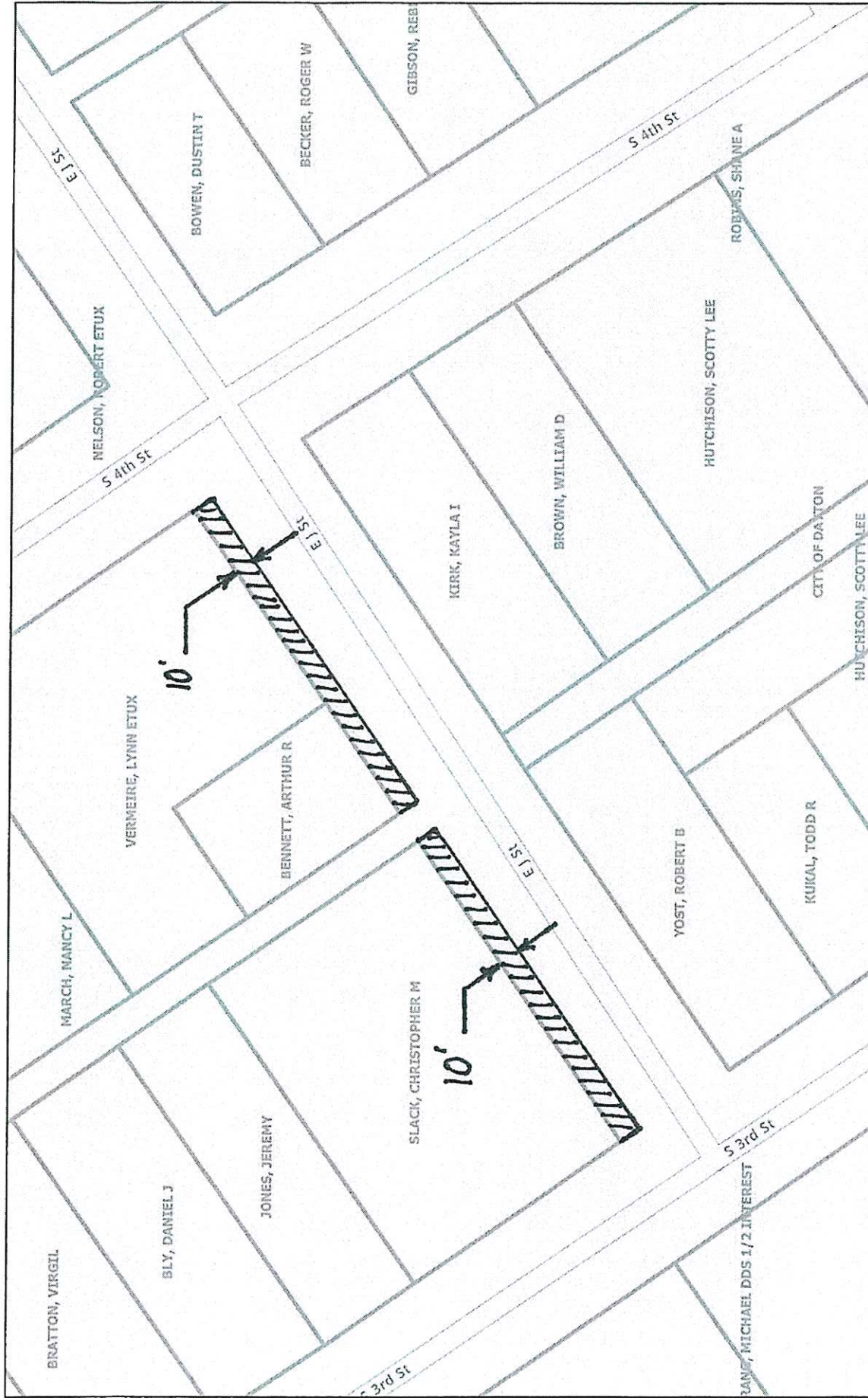
