A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO TAKE TESTIMONY FOR OR AGAINST THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY ON EAST J STREET

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Dayton pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW to vacate public right-of-way located in the City of Dayton, Washington; and,

WHEREAS, the petition received requests vacation of a portion of E. J St., between S. 3rd St. and S. 4th St.; and,

WHEREAS, the portion of the right-of-way is 10' wide and is along the north side of E. J St. between S. 3rd St. and S. 4th St.; and,

WHEREAS, the portion of the right-of-way being petitioned to be vacated is a total of 3,392 square feet; and,

WHEREAS, the current infrastructure development does not utilize the entirety of the right-of-way; and,

WHEREAS, 100% of adjoining property owners have signed the petition requesting vacation of the right-of-way; and,

WHEREAS, the public hearing on such petition may be held before the legislative authority upon the date fixed by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> Pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW, it is the intention of the City of Dayton to hold a public hearing concerning the vacation of a portion of E. J St.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> Pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW, a public hearing is hereby set for May 12, 2021 at 6:00 pm. The public hearing hereby requests testimony for or against the proposed vacation and will be held by the Dayton City Council. All persons interested may appear and be heard.




