WHEREAS, the City Council, from time to time, has authorized a Council's Discretionary Holiday.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dayton, Columbia County, Washington, as follows:


Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon passage and signatures hereon.






