

## RESOLUTION 1534

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, ACKNOWLEDGING THE COLUMBIA COUNTY PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 36.69 RCW authorizes the creation of park and recreation districts within the State of Washington as municipal corporations for the purpose of providing leisure time activities and facilities and recreational facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, more than 10% of the voters who voted in the 2023 general election have signed a petition to put on the 2023 general election ballot a proposition to form a Columbia County Park and Recreation Pool District: and

**WHEREAS**, these valid signatures were determined to be sufficient in number; and

**WHEREAS**, a measure to establish a Park and Recreation Pool District was properly advertised and placed on the 2023 general ballot: and

**WHEREAS**, a majority of the voters in the general election of 2023 approved the measure to establish the Columbia County Park and Recreation Pool District; and


**WHEREAS**, the Columbia County Board of Commissioners declared the Columbia County Park and Recreation Pool District formed, as required by RCW 36.69.080, with the adoption of Columbia County Resolution 2024-04 on January 16, 2024

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON**, as follows:


