

RESOLUTION NO. 1453

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON,
WASHINGTON, REJECTING THE BID RECEIVED FOR THE FRONT ST
BRIDGE RAILING REPAIR PROJECT**

WHEREAS, a car accident caused property damage to the easterly side of the N. Front Street Bridge, hereinafter referred to as "Bridge"; and

WHEREAS, the City engineer has determined it is necessary to repair the Bridge to eliminate safety issues created by said accident; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited sealed public bids for the Front Street Bridge Railing Repair project; and

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2020, a single sealed bid was received and opened by the City; and

WHEREAS, the single bid received substantially exceeded the engineer's estimate and the available funding for the project; and

WHEREAS, the cost for repairs to the Bridge will be provided by the City's insurance; and

WHEREAS, on December 24, 2020, the City's insurance carrier requested the City rebid the Front Street Bridge Railing Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.23.352(1), the City Council may, by resolution, reject all bids and authorize further calls for bids in the same manner as the original call.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. BID REJECTION. All bids received for the Front Street Bridge Railing Repair Project are hereby rejected.

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to make further calls for bids in the same manner as the original call for this project.

SECTION 3. IMPLEMENTATION. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to implement such administrative procedures as may be necessary to carry out the directions of this legislation.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon passage and signatures hereon.
