

**RESOLUTION NO. 1457**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING TO TAKE TESTIMONY FOR OR AGAINST THE VACATION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY ON EAST J STREET**

**WHEREAS**, a petition has been filed with the City of Dayton pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW to vacate public right-of-way located in the City of Dayton, Washington; and,

**WHEREAS**, the petition received requests vacation of a portion of E. J St., east of S. 6<sup>th</sup> St.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the portion of the right-of-way is 60' X 120' and is undeveloped vacant land and "dead ends" into the City Cemetery; and,

**WHEREAS**, 100% of adjoining property owners have signed the petition requesting vacation of the right-of-way; and,

**WHEREAS**, the public hearing on such petition may be held before the legislative authority upon the date fixed by resolution:

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW, it is the intention of the City of Dayton to hold a public hearing concerning the vacation of a portion of E. J St.

SECTION 2: Pursuant to Chapter 35.79 RCW, a public hearing is hereby set for April 14, 2021 at or shortly thereafter 6:00 pm. The public hearing hereby requests testimony for or against the proposed vacation and will be held by the Dayton City Council via Zoom. All persons interested may appear and be heard.
