

RESOLUTION NO. 1512

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO ANDERSON PERRY & ASSOCIATES SOUTH 3RD STREET SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING – TASK ORDER 2-E-924(008)-1 FOR THE SOUTH 3RD STREET PROJECT FOR ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING COSTS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$61,000.00 .

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton (hereinafter "City") has previously entered into a Services Agreement with Anderson Perry & Associates, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires to approve Task Order 2-E-924(008)-1, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, so as to allow for Anderson Perry & Associates, Inc. to perform construction engineering services related to the South 3rd Street Project, not to exceed \$61,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF AGREEMENT. The City Council hereby authorizes Task Order 2-E-924(008)-1, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, so as to allow for Anderson Perry & Associates, Inc. to perform construction engineering services related to the South 3rd Street Project, not to exceed \$61,000.


SECTION 2. EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute Task Order 2-E-924(008)-1 on behalf of the City of Dayton.

SECTION 3. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to implement such administrative procedures as may be necessary to carry out the directions of this legislation.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon passage and signatures hereon.
