RESOLUTION NO. 1501

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, COLUMBIACOUNTY, WASHINGTON, TERMINATING THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WITH TOUCHET VALLEY TELEVISION, INC., AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 1832

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton adopted Ordinance No 1832 in April 2013 granting a non-exclusive franchise to Touchet Valley Television, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Touchet Valley Televisions, Inc., has failed to comply with the terms and conditions of the franchise agreement, including the requirement in section 14 of the franchise agreement to maintain comprehensive general liability insurance and designate the City as an additional insured; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated April 5, 2022, the City gave Touchet Valley Television, Inc., formal notice pursuant to Section 19 of the franchise agreement of the City's determination that Touchet Valley Television, Inc., was non-compliant with the franchise agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City further informed Touchet Valley Television, Inc., that the City would terminate the franchise agreement unless it came into compliance with all terms and conditions of the franchise agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City has received no response from Touchet Valley Television, Inc., and no information that Touchet Valley Television, Inc., has come into compliance with Section 14 of the franchise agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the franchise agreement should be terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTONWASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Franchise Agreement between the City of Dayton and Touchet Valley Television, Inc., authorized pursuant to City of Dayton Ordinance No. 1832 is hereby terminated.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon passage and signatures here on.
