A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A BAN ON THE USE OF CONSUMER FIREWORKS DUE TO THE EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS IN THE CITY OF DAYTON FROM JULY 2 TO JULY 5, 2015.

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton needs to protect property within the city limits, and

WHEREAS, citizens are not to set off fireworks this year to ensure safety of property, and

WHEREAS, citizens of Dayton are responsible stewards of their property.

NOW, THEREFORE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS :

Section 1. **Fireworks Ban July 2-5, 2015.** The City of Dayton hereby bans consumers fireworks in the City of Dayton from July 2-5, 2015 due to the extreme fire hazard in the City.
