

RESOLUTION NO. 1303

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING AN INTERFUND TRANSFER FROM THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NETTING SYSTEM TO ASSIST WITH ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES AND AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE CITY OF DAYTON 2017 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, animal control services are provided by the City and its Current Expense Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide safe, humane and effective capturing of animals by purchasing a netting system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the purchase of a netting system for animal control purposes as part of the City of Dayton 2017 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the netting system is considered a capital outlay expenditure;

WHEREAS, as prescribed by Section 3.1.7.50, Fund Types and Accounting, Type of Funds, of the Washington State Auditor Budgeting, Accounting, Reporting System, capital outlay acquisitions should be made from a capital projects fund; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvements Fund serves as the capital outlay fund for the Current Expense Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council authorizes an interfund transfer from the Current Expense Fund to the Capital Improvements Fund for \$2,500 for the purchase of a netting system for animal control services.

Section 2. That the City Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to implement such administrative procedures as may be necessary to carry out the directions of this legislation.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force upon passage.
