

RESOLUTION NO. 1341

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, AWARDED THE BID FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FEMA STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO HUMBERT ASPHALT, INC. AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH HUMBERT ASPHALT, INC. FOR SAID WORK.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dayton (“City”) desires to perform the FEMA Street Repairs Project (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City solicited “Invitations to Bid” from individual construction firms qualified to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City received two bids in response to the City’s “Invitation to Bid”;
and

WHEREAS, Humbert Asphalt, Inc., was the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City’s engineer, Anderson Perry & Associates, Inc., Washington Military Department Emergency Management Division and Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Division have reviewed the bid documents submitted by Humbert Asphalt, Inc., and has found them to be substantially complete; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting that the City Council award the bid to Humbert Asphalt, Inc., and that the Mayor be granted the authority to execute a Public Works Contract with Humbert Asphalt, Inc., to perform the construction of the Project in the total bid amount of \$686,210.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DO RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bid Award. The City Council hereby awards the bid for construction services for the FEMA Repairs Project to the lowest responsible bidder, Humbert Asphalt, Inc.

Section 2. Authorization. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a Public Works Construction Contract with Humbert Asphalt, Inc. to perform the construction services for FEMA Repairs Project in the total bid amount of \$686,210.


