

RESOLUTION NO. 1400

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
DAYTON, COLUMBIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REPEALING
RESOLUTION NOS. 1290, 1298, 1330 AND 1373; AND,
ADOPTING THE 2020 MASTER FEE SCHEDULE**

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted a Master Fee Schedule establishing service fees and charges and such Master Fee Schedule has been revised and amended from time to time;

WHEREAS, the fees and charges that the City establishes for various services are intended to cover but not exceed the City's costs for providing such services; and,

WHEREAS, the Master Fee Schedule now needs further revision to add or change certain fees associated with utility lien filings, tampering with water system, meter lock system installation and removal, planning general processing, planning land division processing, shoreline management, and planning Type V legislative processing.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DAYTON, WASHINGTON, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Repeal. Resolution Nos. 1290, 1298, 1330 and 1373 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 2. Adopt. The 2020 Master Fee Schedule is hereby adopted as set forth and attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be in full force and effect January 1, 2020.
